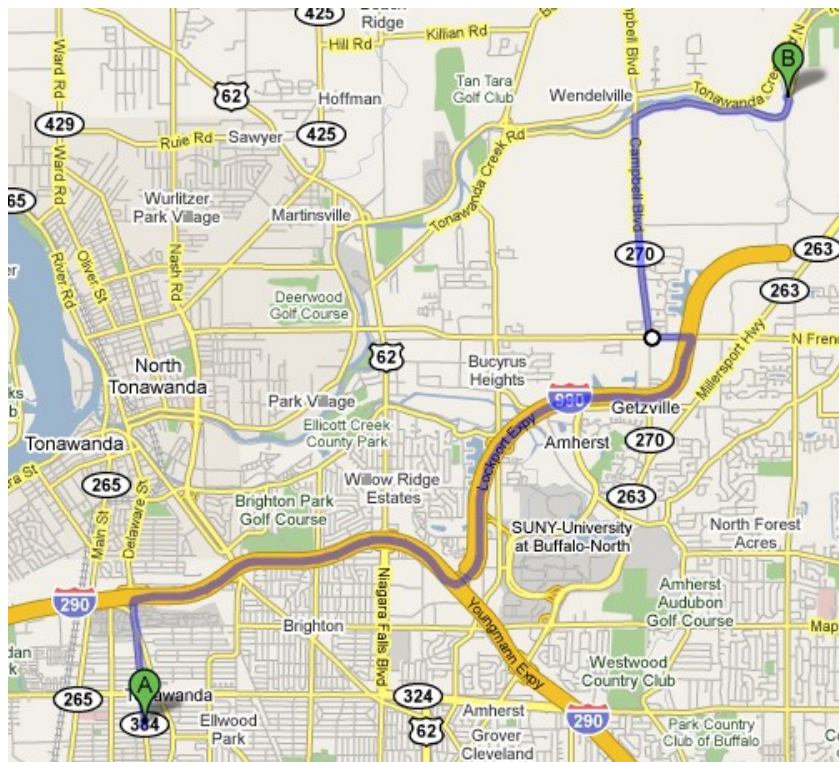


CUB SCOUT

- Family Camp-Out, at 9 Mile Island, June 25, 26, 27.

 - Friday (or Saturday) night we'll have a flag retirement ceremony - bring an old American flag if you have one. Please separate the field of blue & the 13 stripes, as they are placed into the fire one-by-one.
 - Saturday's dinner is at 5:00; awards ceremony is at 7:30.
 - Signup by June 16th for number attending and what you can bring.
 - Bring sports equipment, games, and telescopes etc. - no electronics!
 - This is a family camp-out – parents and siblings are invited. If you need a tent or have questions let us know; we can help you out.
 - Cost is \$10 each for the entire weekend, or \$5 for Saturday's dinner.
- Last Meeting: June 16th meet at St. Paul's for a quick meeting then we'll head out for ice cream
- July 10 / 11th: Adventure Base 100 at the Taste of Buffalo! More info to come...

- Toilet kit – toothpaste and brush, soap, small towel, deodorant, toilet paper, tissues, hand sanitizer
- Hiking Shoes & sneakers
- Clothes For weekend
 - Shorts
 - Pants / Jeans
 - Socks
 - T-Shirts
 - Long-sleeved shirt
 - Sleeping attire (knit hat for cold nights)
 - Underwear - 2 extra
 - Rain gear
- Sweatshirt and/or Jacket
- Hat: a baseball cap for the day and a knit hat a night if it gets cold
- Class "A" uniform (button-down) - for ceremonies
- Class "B" uniform (yellow t-shirt) - for other times
- Water bottle or canteen
- Plastic trash bag - 2
- Large zip lock – 2
- Rain gear (not that we'll need it)
